In Acts 9:33-35, Peter heals a man.

The Holy Spirit works in the \_\_\_\_\_ of people.

In Acts 9:36-43 Peter raises a woman from the dead.

Notice again, it was not Peter doing this. Peter

Comelius has a vision of an angel of God who tells him

Peter has a vision teaching him that God has made all  
food clean, which points to the bigger picture that no  
people are unclean.

God brings Peter and Cornelius together. Peter shares the Good News, and through the power of the Holy Spirit, Cornelius along with his family are brought to faith and baptized.

What does this mean for us?

1. We have to be open to hearing the Holy Spirit.

2. We have to know where to hear the Spirit's direction.
