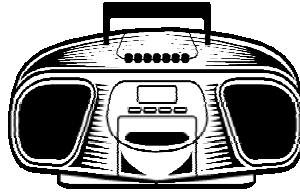

*****Though the “net” numbers are presently positive, we still anticipate a budget shortfall of \$30,000-40,000 by the end of the fiscal year (June 30, 2018). The positive Net Income is a result of higher than anticipated offerings, and an increase in full tuition payments. The first six months of the fiscal year saw 75% of tuition paid for the year. Please know your Church Leadership Team is vigilant to practice God’s standards of good stewardship of His gifts.
