70½ YEARS OLD—YOUR TAX-FREE CHURCH OFFERINGS TO ST. PAUL'S

The IRS mandates that you begin taking money out of your IRA at age 70½. This distribution requirement is often referred to as your "Required Minimum Distribution" (RMD). Your RMD will increase your taxable income and potentially increase the taxes you pay. Before 12/31/2018, please consider directing a portion of your RMD as your monthly or annual offerings to St. Paul's Lutheran Church.

By directing a portion of your RMD to St. Paul's, you will be satisfying your YOUR IRS requirement, lowering your taxable income, and contributing your offerings to St Paul's tax-free. This may save you hundreds, if not thousands, of dollars in Federal and Wisconsin income taxes.
