7 April, A.D. 2019
Deut. 32:36-39; Phil. 2:5-11; John 12:20-43

This Sunday is called both "Palm Sunday" and "Passion Sunday".

We will talk about both.

Jesus died a very real death.

Hebrews 4:15, "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin."

What happened in the garden that happened to us also?

The first death was by whose hands and why?

What was the problem with animal sacrifices?

Jesus came to earth as a human being in every way but without sin.

Luke 1:30-31, "And the angel said to her, 'Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus.'"

Philippians 2:5-8, "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

For Jesus' Triumphal Entry, look at John 12:12-19.

The cross lies at the end of this parade. Our Gospel lesson, John 12:20-43 happens right after Jesus' Triumphal Entry.

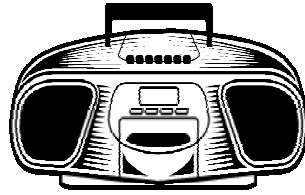

Krista works part-time as the Africa region project coordinator, an unofficial logistics coordinator for various events, a hostess and an enduring and gracious wife and mother.

Shauen was born in northern California and grew up in the Seattle area. He earned

a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Seattle Pacific University and received his Master of Divinity from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis. Shauen enjoys spending time with his wife, playing monster truck show with his children and buying books that he never has time to read.

Krista spent her early childhood in Liberia where her family served with Lutheran Bible Translators. She holds a bachelor's degree in Christian outreach from Concordia University, St. Paul, St. Paul, Minn., and a bachelor's degree in nursing from St. Louis University. Krista previously served through the LCMS in Slovakia from 2003 to 2005. She enjoys baking, buying new kitchen toys, spending time on the coast of Kenya and buying books that she never has time to read. Shauen and Krista have four wonderful boys — Josiah, Elijah, Isaiah and Jeremiah — who join them on the mission field.
