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Prov 8:1-4, 22-31; Acts 2:14a, 22-36; Jn 8:48-59

Today we discuss the Athanasian Creed.

The word "Creed" comes from the Latin word "Credo" which means \_\_\_\_\_.

So a Creed is what?

We live in a world with many gods. All are false except one.

Deuteronomy 4:35, "To you it was shown, that you might know that the Lord is God; there is no other besides him."

1 Timothy 1:17, "To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen."

All roads DON'T lead to Heaven.

First Commandment, "You shall have no other gods."

In general, why were the Creeds written?

False teachings are lies spread by the devil. Do you know of anyone affected by the false teachings?

Here is what Jesus says about Satan.

John 8:44, "You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies."

Who is the Father?

Who is the Son?

Who is the Holy Spirit?

There is only one God, one Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Isaiah 45:21b, "And there is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is none besides me."

Although a great mystery which we receive through faith, we proclaim it boldly to the world.

Matthew 28:19-20, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
